Did You Know?

Parashat Eikev includes the second paragraph of the *Sh'ma*, a central prayer in our liturgy. Moses assures the people that, if they observe God's commandments and remain loyal to Him, they will experience prosperity and good health for all. However,

However, there is a subtle distinction between the first and second sections of the *Sh'ma*. *The first states, V'ahavtah "and you [singular] should love", addressed to the individual. The second part reads, Im shamoa tishm'u el mitzvotai "If you [plural] hear My commandments", speaking to multitudes.*

From this distinction, we learn that we each achieve love for God in our own way, based on individual intellectual and spiritual levels. The second section, however, reveals that observance of *mitzvot* is *optimally achieved when performed as a group, as part of a community.*

We must remember this lesson when considering the present strife within the Jewish community. *Sinat chinam*, "causeless hatred", destroys the community on which we depend to observe the *mitzvot*, just as it led to the destruction of the holy Second Temple. To sustain our communities, we must live according to the mandate of *Kol Yisrael Arevim Zeh laZeh*, "All Israel is responsible one for the other."

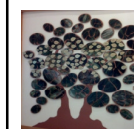
